Avalanche Awareness and Safety by Matthew Lemons of the Hatcher Pass Avalanche Center.

Matthew Lemons. HPAC:

- the presentation concentrated on knowing the signs of an impending avalanche and what to do;
- bottom line -- be aware and don't go unless you get a forecast of the conditions and have training and the proper safety and rescue gear with you;
- explained and demonstrated some of the rescue equipment: avalanche beacon, avalanche shovel, avalung.
