Community: COVID-19 Pandemic- EBT for children now available. Text PEBT to 907-891-8913 to check eligibility

What is P-EBT?

The Pandemic – Electronic Benefits Transfer (P-EBT) Program is additional money for families to buy food due to COVID-19 related school closures in March, April, and May of 2020. This means up to \$458 for each eligible child! You can start at this website to check eligibility <https://anchorageiteam.lpages.co/p-ebt/>

Who will get P-EBT?

The program is available to all Alaskan families with school-age children who received free and reduced-price school meals in Alaska, or attended a school where meals are free during March, April, and May of 2020.



How do I get P-EBT?

If you already receive SNAP (food stamps) benefits will be automatically loaded onto your card. If you don't receive SNAP but receive free or reduced-price school meals, a form to opt-in has been mailed to you. Forms must be mailed back and received by August 31st. **The fastest way to see if you're eligible and apply is to text PEBT to 907-891-8913.**
