Open Enrollment for health insurance through [HealthCare.gov](https://www.healthcare.gov) is available until December 15.

The 800 number offers 24/7 assistance in English, Spanish, and 200+ other languages.

If you had coverage through [HealthCare.gov](https://www.healthcare.gov) for 2020, you should update your information and compare your options for 2021. Every year, plans and prices change, and you could save money by switching to a new plan that still meets your needs. Last year, nearly 8 out of 10 people qualified for financial help to make their monthly premiums more affordable.

You won't be denied care or have to pay more because of a pre-existing condition. [HealthCare.gov](https://www.healthcare.gov) plans cover everything from your prescription drugs and check-ups to maternity care and hospitalizations.

If you have a favorite doctor or take a prescription medication, you can sort through plans to make sure you get the coverage that you need.
